### **UBI confirms investment agreement with top delegation of officials from the city of Nanjing at a signing ceremony in central London.**

**20th April 2010 – London:** Under the auspices of the China-British Business Council, a high level delegation from the city of Nanjing visited the U.K. for a business ceremony and series of company meetings in London. The delegation of over 100 Chinese government and administrative officials was led by the Mayor of Nanjing, Mr.Ji Jianye, and the Directors General of his key government departments from this important and historic city on the banks of the Yangtze River. The signing ceremony underscores the investment agreements made between UBI and Nanjing City.

At the ceremony, officials from the Mayor's delegation from this key strategic city in the region's national development zone took the opportunity to confirm its business and investments agreements with UBI as a Green Enterprise Development and Investments Partner to help meet the city's long-term plans, underpinned by the newly approved and formed Green Enterprise Transformation (GET) Growth Fund of 500 million RMB (50 million GBP). The fund specifically denominated in RMB, is to support the best entrepreneurs in the high-growth areas of green enterprise transformation, makes typical investments in the super-growth green fields of information technology and communications, sustainable engineering and advanced manufacture, innovative biotechnology and digitalised healthcare.

In a keynote speech, Mayor Ji outlined the role which the convergence of financial and technology solutions provided by international companies like UBI would make in the implementation of the city's 'Intelligent Nanjing' transformation program – especially, in the areas of e-commerce, digital media, online audio/video and creative sectors. He also stressed the contribution of low-carbon technologies and innovative green technologies in the growth of the Nanjing city area.
